WELCOME TO THE FIA MOTORSPORT GAMES 2024

The FIA Motorsport Games is a special occasion for drivers to represent their countries through a single entry per discipline, proudly displaying their national flags and symbols throughout the competition.

This year, from October 23 to 27, Valencia will host the largest edition of the event to date.

Valencia will come alive with 700 drivers from 85 nations, competing across 26 thrilling disciplines, setting the stage for high expectations.

The schedule for the FIA Motorsport Games is set as:

- Opening Ceremony: 23rd October, 19h30 (Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias)
- Racing Live: 24th 27th October (various locations)
- Closing Ceremony: 27th October, 20h30 (Prince Philip Science Museum)













SOCIAL RESPONSABILITY

GENDER EQUALITY

To promote Gender Equality, we have introduced compulsory mixed disciplines.

Furthermore, in collaboration with the WIM Commission, the FIA will sponsor 5 female drivers from ASNs, providing them the opportunity to compete in this prestigious event.

In the ASN Village, we also feature dedicated activities for Girls on Track.

YOUNG DRIVERS' PROMOTION

The event is designed to empower participants at all levels, from grassroots enthusiasts to seasoned professionals.

This year, we will have Karting Mini, the category with the youngest participants, which is aimed at drivers aged between 8 (who reach their 9th birthday during the year) and 11 years old as a maximum (not reaching 12 before 31st December) with a National Karting Licence.

Additionally, Junior Sprint Karting is for drivers with a Grade G FIA International Licence, aged between 11 (who will turn 12 by the end of the year) and 14 years old.

EQUAL ACCESS

In line with our commitment to Social Responsibility and Equal Access, we strive to maximise inclusion.

The Esports Cup provides an opportunity that is both accessible and inclusive, enabling athletes with disabilities to fully participate. For example, this was exemplified by the successful participation of a deaf driver in the inaugural event in 2019.





ENVIRONMENTAL GUIDELINES

CARBON FOOTPRINT

For accurate measurement of the event's carbon footprint, we will require data sets from all event participants, incl. details of:

- All event related travel (number of travelers, distances travelled, and modes of transport used).
- All event related accommodation (total number of room nights booked for event purposes).
- All event related logistics (quantity of fuel consumed, total freight moved (kg) and modes of transport used).
- Any event emissions (all forms of fuel consumed at event for scooters, generators and equivalents).

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

- Prioritizing train travel or car travel rather than flying.
- Use hybrid / electric event vehicles for the duration of the event.
- Carbon compensation for all flights in cases where flying is unavoidable is recommended.
- Using accommodation close to the event venues, when possible.

ENVIRONMENT

- Access for people with disabilities.
- Inclusive event structure.
- Respect the conservation plan for the fauna & flora.
- Respect the sites, natural spaces and infrastructures.
- Favor recycled/eco labelled material for purchases.





ENVIRONMENTAL GUIDELINES

WASTE

Recycling

- Waste needs to be correctly separated and fed into the existing recycling infrastructure.
- Reuse any items suitable for repeated usage.
- Reduce printing whenever possible.
- Eliminate single use plastics.

Food Waste

- Submit meal orders by September 30th (optimize food quantities & avoid waste).
- Correctly separate food waste & other compostable material.

Tyre Collection

 Ensure 100% of tyres used are sent back to the tyre provider for recycling.

WATER

- Water Consumption: Use water refill stations available onsite.
- Clean Discharge: Ensure all wastewater discharged is done so in a safe manner and does not cause any contamination of water causes or the local environment.
- <u>Chemicals:</u> Ensure all chemicals used are safely discharged in appropriate manners.







HOST CITY - VALENCIA (SPAIN)

Valencia, a vibrant region located on Spain's eastern coast, is a city known for its rich history, lively culture, and modern attractions.

Each March, the famous Las Fallas festival fills its streets with colourful celebrations. The city also boasts the peaceful beauty of Albufera Natural Park and the impressive architecture of the Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias. Valencia is a culinary hotspot, celebrated for its traditional dish, paella, and delectable seafood.

For sports enthusiasts, Valencia offers top-tier events like MotoGP competitions at the Circuit Ricardo Tormo, drawing fans from across the globe.







HOST CITY - VALENCIA (SPAIN)



CLIMATE

In October, the weather in and around Valencia area has an average high temperature of 23 °C (73 °F), and an average low temperature of 13 °C (55 °F).

Rainfall during October is moderate with an average of 89mm.

The average wind speed in October at Valencian region and Ricardo Tormo very low and coming dominantly from the South.



TIME ZONE

The province of Valencia, Spain, is currently in the Central European Summer Time (CEST) zone, UTC +2 and will change to Standard time (Central European Time (CET), UTC +1) starting on October 27, 2024. Important to note for all activities run on the Sunday of the event.



LANGUAGE

The two official languages spoken in the city are Spanish and Valencian. For instance, all signs and announcements in the Metro are in Valencian, with Spanish translations underneath.

English is relatively commonly spoken is all areas.



CURRENCY

The currency in circulation in Spain is the Euro (EUR).





HOST CITY - VALENCIA (SPAIN)



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Valencia has 10 clean, safe and reliable metro lines. Some of them are actually partially or entirely above ground. Parking is limited and costly in the city.

Please consider taking public transport to reach the Opening and Closing Ceremony as well as for the Esports competitions.



According to the Spanish Government, 99.5% of all public water in Spain is potable, which means it's safe to drink and cook with. So, during your stay in Spain, feel free to enjoy the tap water without worries.



ELECTRICITY

Power in Spain runs on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz.

Always check that the electrical appliances you are going to use operate at this voltage.







The event will be live streamed. The respective footage will be provided to the National Delegations so that they can use it to improve the promotion of their National Team/Delegation.





PRIZES AND AWARDS

MEDALS

The following medals are awarded in each discipline of the FIA Motorsport Games:

• 1st place: Gold Medal

• 2nd place: Silver Medal

• 3rd place: Bronze Medal

The best 10 medal results per nation are taken into account for the overall medal table.

WINNER'S TROPHY

The FIA Motorsport Games 2024 overall title will be awarded to the nation which has won the highest amount of gold medals. The best results from maximum 10 disciplines per ASN are taken into account for the overall medal table.

In case of a draw, the trophy shall be awarded to:

- a) If the number of Gold medals is the same, the holder of the greatest number of Silver medals.
- b) If the number of Silver medals is the same, the holder of the greatest number of Bronze medals.
- c) At this stage, if there are still ASNs tied on Medals, the number of 4th, 5th, 6th (and so on) positions in the Final Classifications of each discipline will be taken into account in order to determine the rankings of the medal tables. Following this, if ASNs can still not be divided by their results, they will be classified in equal position and any prize shall be shared.



PRIZES AND AWARDS

REGIONAL TROPHIES

Regional Trophies are granted to the following five FIA Regions:

Africa, Americas, Asia Pacific, Europe & MENA

The winning national team per region is awarded with the Regional Trophy, given to the nation who has won the highest amount of Gold medals over 10 of the 26 event disciplines.

In case of a draw, the same rules as for the Overall Winner's Trophy apply.

ALLSTAR TROPHY

The AllStar Trophy is awarded to the national team with the highest medal scores in the following disciplines:

GT, GT Sprint, GT Single-Make, Touring Car, F4, Rally2, Rally4, Historic Rally, Drifting, Cross Car Sr, Karting Sprint Sr

The Nation with the best results in the abovementioned disciplines is awarded with the AllStar Trophy.

In case of a draw, the same rules as for the Overall Winner's Trophy apply.

NEWSTAR TROPHY

The NewStar Trophy is awarded to the national team with the highest medal scores in the following disciplines:

Karting Endurance, Karting Sprint Jr, Karting Mini, Karting Slalom, Auto Slalom, Cross Car Jr, Cross Car Mini, Esports F4, Esports GT

The upraising motor sport stars rewarded with medals in the abovementioned disciplines are contributing to their nation's success in winning the NewStar Trophy.

In case of a draw, the same rules as for the Overall Winner's Trophy apply.




Delegation members must pay for their own catering, with the cost being €28.60 per meal per person.
